pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC

The Purpose and Lawful Basis of Personal Data Processing:

Your personal data and sensitive personal information shall be processed in the scope in which you provided them, primarily **in connection with performance of lawful obligations** and **with regard to entering into a contractual or another similar relation** with us. Your personal data may be further processed for the **purpose of protection of rights** and legitimate interest of our organisation as the **controller** (e.g. in connection with the exercise of lawful claims in court proceedings).

Your contact personal data are processed with the aim to contact you back and provide you information you asked us for.

Your personal data are processed in full compliance with valid legal regulations.

Personal Data Recipients:

We pass your personal data on public authorities, i.e. public administration, bodies involved in criminal proceedings, courts, executors, notaries, bankruptcy administrators, etc.

Personal Data Categories:

Personal data subject to the processing are:

- basic identification and contact data
- addresses

Transfer of Personal Data Abroad:

Your personal data are not exported to countries outside the EU.

Time of Personal Data Storing:

Your personal data are processed for a period of time necessary for ensuring rights and obligations resulting from respective legal regulations as well as for the time of validity of a contract signed with

you. After the period of time necessary for the processing your personal data shall be disposed in compliance with respective legal regulations.

Rights Applicable to Personal Data Protection:

In connection with personal data processing you have **the right to request information** how your personal data have been processed, you have the right to ask for **access to your personal data**, including the right to **correction** thereof if you discover any incorrectness of the data. You have the right to amend your incomplete personal data anytime. You have the right to **erasure** of your personal data if you are convinced that the purpose of processing thereof expired and they are not of any use to us in that particular case. Your right to erase of your personal data is, however, limited by our legal obligations. The right to **transferability** of personal data to another explicitly specified controller may be exercised provided it is not prevented by any legal obstacles. You have the right to ask us to **restrict processing** of your personal data. You have the **right to raise an objection** to the processing which is based on our legitimate interests or which is necessary for achieving a target in public interest or execution of public authority.

In case that you assume that by processing of your personal data your rights in the field of personal data protection are violated you have the **right to lodge a complaint** with the Office for Personal Data Protection.

Provision of your personal data is necessary to enable fulfilment of contractual obligations.

Information related to the exercise of the right to access to personal data shall be provided **within one month** from the receipt of your application. The time limit may be reasonably extended considering the complexity and number of applications by maximum another two months. Information is provided free of charge. Evidently unjustified and undue requests for information may be charged or rejected.
